At the sports day, students are divided into blue and red blocks. Under block leaders, they compete in mixed-grade teams, demonstrating active participation and enthusiasm in the events.






Human Rights Lesson

Our school holds a contest where students improve their skills by teaching each other English words and math problems.


School Cultural Presentation Day
