Students take a CPR and Chest Compression class, learning how to help in emergencies.



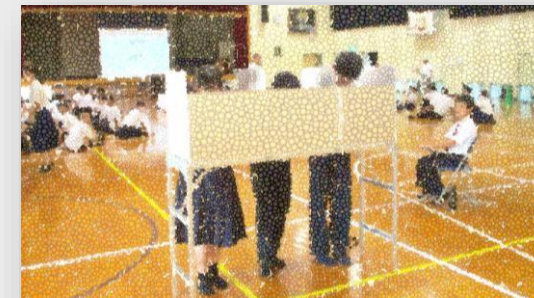
### **High School Information Session**
